

# Minor in Psychology

## COURSE REQUIREMENTS

A minor in Psychology can be an extremely valuable addition to a wide variety of majors. The minor in Psychology consists of (1) General Psychology; (2) at least three Psychology Core courses listed below; and (3) three additional Psychology courses from list 2 and/or list 3 below. Essentially, you take General Psychology and 6 more courses, 3 of which must be Psychology Core courses, and 3 of which can be chosen from *either* the Psychology Core list or the Psychology Elective list or a combination of the two.

If you wish to use a 3-hour course not listed here, ask the Psychology undergraduate advisor if that is possible.

*Important:* When you apply for your degree, be sure to claim Psychology as a minor in addition to listing your major. That way, your transcript will be sent to the Psychology Department for verification, and your Minor in Psychology will become an official part of your work here.
